We are pleased to announce that applications are now being taken for Wayne State University's **Master of Arts in Teaching Artistry** for entering FALL 2018

The Master of Arts is a part-time program of advanced studies in theatre and dance, designed to provide specialized training in:

- Research Methods, Arts in Human Development
- Principles of Teaching Artistry and Artistic Praxis,
 - Pedagogical Foundations

Professional Training: The program equips artists, educators and community workers with practical knowledge and research skills necessary for effective engagement of communities through arts experiences. Bringing together the most current theories and practices of arts engagement, students are trained in an environment that fosters cultural sensitivity, problem-solving skills and ensemble-based thinking and creativity. With this degree, students may continue or pursue careers in teaching artistry, arts administration, arts advocacy and arts entrepreneurship.

Flexible: The M.A. is offered in two formats: the fully online program provides the most flexibility for working professionals and those living outside the Detroit metro area; the hybrid program enables students to combine online learning in required courses with face-to-face instruction in elective coursework.

Affordable: Out of state students who enroll in the fully online program qualify for in-state tuition, one of the lowest rates in the nation.

The online application is no available for entrance in Fall 2018. Application deadline is June 1, 2018
